Safer drug consumption services (SCS) are proposed health care settings where people can more safely use pre-obtained drugs in a hygienic environment with access to sterile drug use equipment and under the supervision of trained healthcare staff. SCS sites would also provide healthcare, counseling, and linkage to other services, including drug treatment.

Charles Hawthorne is the Capacity Building Coordinator for the Harm Reduction Coalition, working to foster partnerships with other organizations in the Bay Area that do social justice and harm reduction work while helping to expand reach and capacity to communities experiencing disproportionately punitive impacts of racialized drug policies.
