Daniel Buford will lead a group discussion that will examine history, worldviews, values, and operations that weaponize modern racist language in politics and media.

As a trainer and curriculum developer for the People's Institute for Survival and Beyond, Buford created a method of propaganda analysis called "linguistic racism". This shows the impact of racism on language, politics, and social behavior.

The skills and insights gained from this session will be invaluable for people concerned about the ongoing divisive harm of racist hate speech and public policies. Daniel Buford's approach values respect for human rights as the nucleus for the struggle for equity and equality.
