

# Allocations to Support the Black Community

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHERE DO I GET MY CHECK



Black individuals and organizations will not sign up to receive checks. The money will go through a Request for Proposals (RFP) process. Nonprofit organizations with 501c3 status will have to apply for funding. The funds will be allocated for individuals, businesses, etc but distributed through a non profit

### HOW LONG BEFORE THE MONEY GETS TO THE PEOPLE?



The Request for Proposals will be developed in October, released in November, with selection and contracting beginning in December. Funds should be available beginning in late December, early January.

### WHERE IS THE MONEY NOW?



Currently, the money sits with three departments - Department of Public Health, Office of Economic and Workforce Development and the Human Rights Commission.

The Human Rights Commission will support a community process to design the allocation/release of funds


### NEXT STEPS

September - allocate resources develop pilot projects

October - work with departments to create RFP (request for proposal)

November - release RFP


December - select grantees, begin contracting process
