# HELP AGAINST HATE

**HATE VIOLENCE OR THE THREAT OF HATE VIOLENCE IS ILLEGAL.** It can be verbal or written threats; physical assault or attempted assault; hate-related graffiti, including offensive symbols; bomb threats; arson; disturbance of religious meetings; cross burning; vandalism; or property damage that is done **because of a “protected class” such as race, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, and others.**
