San Francisco Human Rights Commission to Host Human Rights Day Celebration with Special Guest Actor, Producer, Humanitarian and San Francisco Native Danny Glover

(San Francisco, CA) The San Francisco Human Rights Commission (SFHRC) is pleased to announce its Human Rights Day observance and celebration featuring special guest actor, producer, humanitarian and San Francisco native Danny Glover. The event is scheduled for Sunday, December 10, 2017 at the City's War Memorial Building in the Green Room.

Human Rights Day is observed every year on December 10th – the day the United Nations General Assembly adopted, in 1948, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. This year, Human Rights Day kicks off a year-long campaign to mark the upcoming 70th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, a milestone document that proclaimed the inalienable rights which everyone is inherently entitled to as a human being -- regardless of race, color, religion, sex, language, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status. It is the most translated document in the world, available in more than 500 languages.

The San Francisco Human Rights Commission is spearheading the City's Human Rights Day celebration and observance and will be joined by actor, humanitarian and San Francisco native Danny Glover kicking off the main event at 2:00pm. Glover is well respected for his wide-reaching community activism and philanthropic efforts, with a particular emphasis on advocacy for economic justice and access to health care and education programs in the United States and Africa. He has served as a Goodwill Ambassador for the United Nations Development Program and as UNICEF Ambassador.

Standing up for equality, justice and human dignity is the foundation for the celebration and observance commemorating the 70th Anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.
